I agree to assume all responsibility and liabilities for the actions and behaviors of my family, my guests, and myself. I agree to sign the attached Release and Indemnification agreement. I agree to abide by the range rules explained to me at the MANDATORY range orientation class.

- 1) Member realizes that there are hazards on the shooting range and member assumes all risks in connection with such hazards. Member further agrees and understands that the operator assumes no liabilities for the safety of the member and member's guest and property. Member further agrees to release the operator, his agents and/or employees from any liability for damages or injury to the person or property of member that might occur on the shooting range.
- 2) Cumulative of the foregoing, member agrees to indemnify and hold the operator and his agents, and/or employees from any liability or claim for injury or damages to the person and/or property of the member occurring on the shooting range.
- 3) Safety is paramount, and is the personal responsibility of each and every authorized user of the range. The basic rules of safety and gun handling will be observed at all times. FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES WILL RESULT IN: removal from the range, and may result in forfeiture of memberships and fees paid.

===== RANGE RULES =====

These Range Rules will be in effect any time the club range is in use with the exception of special event shoots.

- 1) Proper muzzle control will be observed at all times.
- 2) No handling of firearms during a cease fire. Clear weapon and stand behind shooting bench.
- 3) All firearms will be treated as if they are loaded at all times.
- 4) Only shooters and coaches/trainers allowed on the firing line. Spectators will remain well behind the firing line.
- 5) No loose caps or open powder on the firing line.
- 6) Misfires will be cleared before anyone goes downrange.
- 7) No loading or capping of firearms until they are on the firing line and muzzle control is observed.
- 8) All shooting will be directed into the berms.
- 9) Appropriate targets will be used so that bullets, shot, et cetera, strike the berm.
- 10) No tracer or other incendiary ammunition is allowed.
- 11) Eye and ear protection is required for shooters and others while on the firing line and while in the proximity of the firing line, including the parking area.
- 12) Regular members are responsible for their children, guests, and pets (including eye/ear protection).
- 13) No smoking on the firing line, and no alcoholic beverages allowed on the range at any time.
- 14) No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs allowed on the range at any time.
- 15) For your safety, lock the gate every time you go through it.
- 16) These Range Rules are intended to provide a safe shooting environment. They are intended to encourage safe and responsible use of the Shooting Range. The Club can limit the use of the range beyond the Range Rules set forth above if the Club deems any use to be unsafe or irresponsible.
